Cutting Instructions


White-on-White:

-  6... 2⁷/₈" squares
-  5... 4¹/₂" squares

Black:

-  8... 2¹/₂" squares
-  6... 2⁷/₈" squares

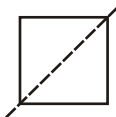
Pink:

-  12... 2¹/₂" squares

Sewing Instructions

Construct half-square triangle units:

Cut six 2⁷/₈" white squares on the diagonal.
Cut six 2⁷/₈" black squares on the diagonal.



Sew one white triangle to one black triangle, right sides together to make a half-square triangle unit. Make twelve units.

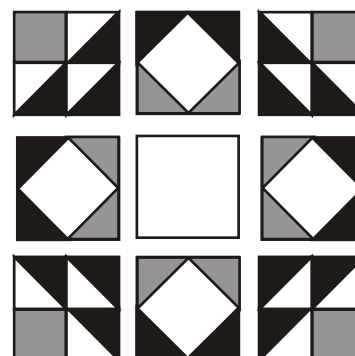
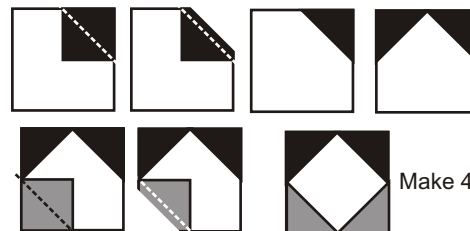
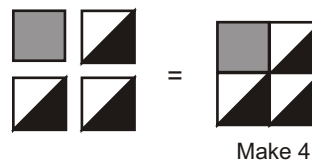
Construct four-patch corner units:

Sew three white and black half-square triangles and one pink 2¹/₂" square to make corner unit. Make 4 units.

Construct square-in-a-square units:

With right sides together, place a black 2¹/₂" square on corner of white 4¹/₂" square and stitch diagonally. Trim 1/4" from stitching line and press outward. Add a black 2¹/₂" square to adjacent corner and press outward. Use same method to add two pink 2¹/₂" squares to opposite side of block. Make 4 units.

Sew blocks together in rows, adding white 4¹/₂" square in center. Sew rows together to finish the block.
