Cutting Instructions

White-on-White:

□ 2... 5¼" squares
8... 2½" squares

Black:

■ 2... 5¼" squares
8... 2½" squares

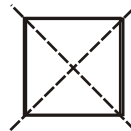
Yellow:

■ 4... 2½" squares
1... 4½" square

Sewing Instructions

Construct quarter-square triangle units:

Cut two 5¼" white squares twice on the diagonal.
Cut two 5¼" black squares twice on the diagonal.



Make 8

Make 4

Sew 2 white triangles to 2 black triangles, right side together to make 8 half-square triangle units.

Sew 4 white and black half-square triangle units in pairs, right side together to make 4 quarter-square triangle units. Trim to 4½" square.



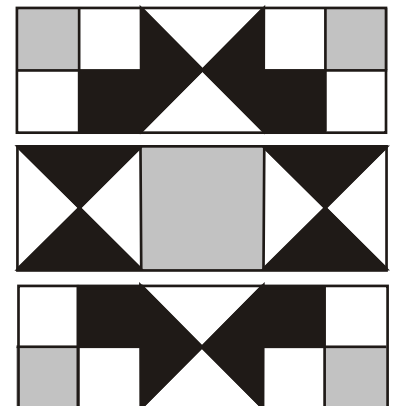

Construct 4-patch units:

Sew 1 black 2½ square to 1 white 2½" square. Sew 1 yellow 2½ square to 1 white 2½" square. Join units together as shown to make 4-patch. Make 4.

Sew blocks together in rows. Sew rows together to finish the block.
