### Cutting Instructions


#### White-on-White:

-  8... 2½" squares
- 2... 2⅞" squares
- 2... 4½" squares
- 1... 4⅞" square

#### Black:

-  2... 2½" squares
- 2... 2⅞" squares
- 1... 4½" square
- 1... 4⅞" square

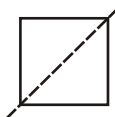
#### Yellow:

-  4... 2½" squares

### Sewing Instructions

#### Construct half-square triangle units:

Cut two 2⅞" white squares on the diagonal. Cut two 2⅞" black squares on the diagonal.



Sew one white triangle to one black triangle, right sides together to make a half-square triangle unit. Make four units.

Repeat with one 4⅞" white and one 4⅞" black square to make large corner units. Make two units.

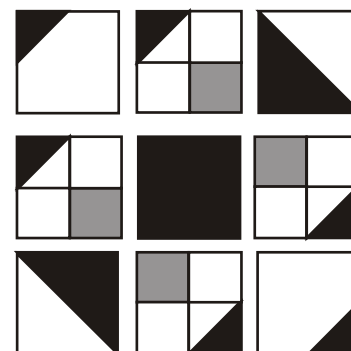
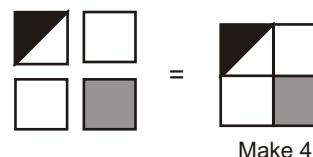
#### Construct 4-patch units:

Sew two white 2½" squares, one yellow 2½" square and one black and white half square triangle unit together to make a 4-patch. Make 4 units.

#### Construct alternate corner units:

With right sides together, place a black 2½" square on corner of white 4½" square and stitch diagonally. Trim ¼" from stitching line and press outward. Make two units.

Sew blocks together in rows, adding black 4½" square in center. Sew rows together to finish the block.
