


All the Rage!


Black and white quilts are "All the Rage!", so this year we are designing a quilt with black, white and a splash of color. Collect a free pattern each month and join us in making a quilt that is sure to be All the Rage!

Cutting Instructions


White:

-  18... 2½" squares
- 8... 2⅞" squares

Black:

-  2... 2½" squares
- 8... 2⅞" squares

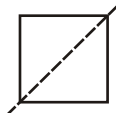
Red:

-  4... 2½" x 4½" rectangles

Sewing Instructions

Construct half-square triangle units:

Cut eight 2⅞" white squares on the diagonal.
Cut eight 2⅞" black squares on the diagonal.



Sew one white triangle to one black triangle, right sides together to make a half-square triangle unit. Make sixteen units.

Sew three white and black half-square triangles and one white 2½" square together as shown to make corner unit. Make 4 units.

Construct flying geese units:

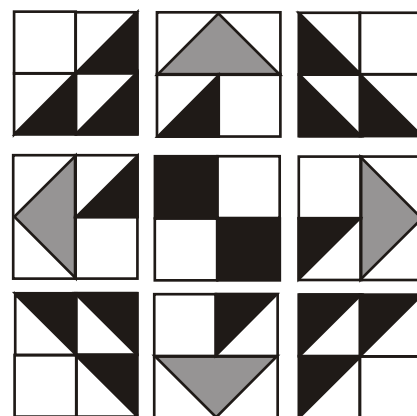
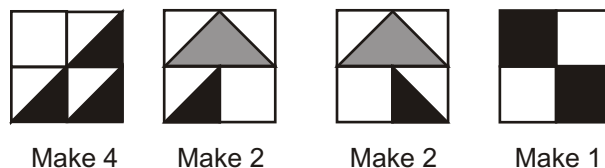
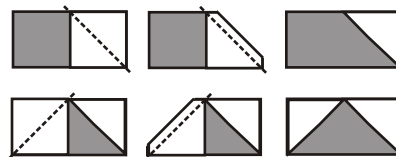
With right sides together, place a white 2½" square on corner of a red 2½" x 4½" rectangle and stitch diagonally. Trim ¼" from stitching line and press outward. Add a second white 2½" square to adjacent corner and press outward.

Sew each flying geese unit to a white and black half-square triangle unit and 2½" white square as shown. Make 4 units.

Construct center four-patch unit:

Sew two 2½" white squares and two 2½" black squares together as shown to make one four-patch unit.

Sew blocks together in rows. Sew rows together to finish the block.
