We do not give a refund, credit or roll you over to another class for cancellations made seven or fewer days prior to the class.*

Class attendance is limited to paid registrants only. Please do not bring guests or children to class.

**SUPPLY LIST** (bring the following to class):

Rotary cutting supplies including fresh rotary blade, mat and ruler

Sewing machine in good working order and basic machine supplies (extra needles, filled bobbins)

**FABRICS:**

**Focus fabric** —3 to 6 yards (more if you plan to use it in each round of the quilt)

**Background fabric** — 3 to 6 yards you might choose to use 2 different background fabrics, alternating from round to round. \*\*Split 9-Patch border (yellow quilt) requires about 3 yards of background.

**Accent fabrics** - 1 1/2 yards each of at least 10 fabrics in a range of light to dark and varying “textures” and pattern scales. \*\*This will allow enough fabric to make a bargello border.

*All fabrics need not be purchased before the beginning of class as fabric placement in initial rounds of quilt might suggest additional fabric choices as the quilt grows. This quilt is a commitment of time and fabric which will enrich your quilting knowledge and enjoyment as well as result in a beautiful quilt to enjoy for many years to come. Expect to delight in your own “growing” design and in those of other classmates, as each round of the quilt adds to its beauty.*
